

CHEER PARENT PARTICIPATION

- **All Cheer Meetings are Mandatory** and if you can not make one you must E-mail the Cheer Advisor and set up a time to receive your handouts. **It is your responsibility to find out what you missed not anyone else's.**
- This program will not run without **all** the parents involved. It is mandatory that if your daughter is on the squad you must help in the areas below. If you have more than 1 daughter in the program you must help in 1 area per daughter. It can be a mom, dad or any other adult family member.
- If you are helping in a certain area you must be on time and follow your job through completion of all responsibilities.
- The advisor and coaches have many responsibilities and the whole squad to deal with. For the program to run properly we need parents to do their job and be responsible for **their** daughter. **Remember, we are still all raising our children; they are not mature adults as of yet. Let's teach them properly.**
- It is the parents responsibility to turn in all monies on time to the financially office.
- We do have forms to fill out from time and time and it is very important to turn them into the advisor or coach ASAP.

Parents please always are aware of the fact that "it is not what you say, but how you say it".

- Making sure your daughter is not absent or tardy and is on time to games, practice, competitions and any other cheer event. Remember dates and times do change and are still mandatory.
- Making sure your daughter has all her uniforms and other clothes cleaned and with her at the proper times (see check lists that are sent out)
- Making sure your daughter is fed before practice, games and competitions.
- Making sure your daughter has water with her and healthy snacks at practice, games and competitions.
- Making sure your daughter has money in her cheer bag (at least \$10.00).
- If your daughter is sick you must call the coach. If they are not in school for 4 classes you must get permission from the cheer coach for them to be at practice or a game.
- Read all your cheer e-mails, (there are times when I send e-mails every day and more than once) hand outs and pay close attention to the cheer calendar.
